INSECT PREFERENCE BY SPECIES

Wren	Almost 100% insectivore - Aphid eaters!
Finches	Aphids, caterpillars, plant live, weevils
Bushtits	Aphids and other small insects
Rufous-sided Towhee	Especially Gypsy moth larvae
Sparrows	Snails, slugs, flies, Gypsy moth in all stages
Robin	Worms, slugs, snails
Titmouse	Moths, scale, ants insect eggs
Hummingbirds	Ants, small beetles, and flying insects
Juncos	Ants, beetles, leafhoppers, moths, weevils
Blue Jay	Ants, beetles, Gypsy moth in all stages
Chickadee	Moths and caterpillars

PERENNIALS

Grasses
Milkweed (asclepsia)
Thistle (not Canadian Thistle)
Echinacea
Most seed producing perennials are food for some bird species

ANNUALS
