

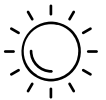


## CARING FOR

# SANSEVIERIA

*Sansevieria*, commonly known as Snake Plant, is a hardy and low-maintenance plant that thrives in various conditions. Follow these care guidelines to ensure its health and vitality:

### Sunlight



Best in indirect low light conditions

### Watering



- Allow the soil to dry out completely between waterings.
- Water sparingly, approximately every 2-4 weeks, depending on humidity and light levels.
- Overwatering can lead to root rot, so err on the side of underwatering.

### Soil



- Use well-draining succulent or cactus potting mix.
- Ensure the pot has drainage holes to prevent waterlogging.

### Pruning



Trim dead or damaged leaves at the base using clean, sharp scissors or pruning shears.

### Propagation



- Easily propagated through leaf cuttings or division of offsets.
- Allow cuttings to dry before planting in soil to prevent rot.
